



KnowledgeWave Learning Site

Associates for Training and Development is pleased to announce a new initiative with a longstanding partner, KnowledgeWave, to provide a virtual technology training platform called KnowledgeWave Learning Site (KLS). KLS is available to all Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) participants and will offer a variety of computer training options, in basic to advanced skills. It is ideal for self-paced learners and combines video, user manuals, and activities.

In the KnowledgeWave Learning Site, participants watch videos and engage with tutorials designed to teach a variety of computer software programs necessary for employment success in the business world. Video content in KLS is provided in three different ways: 1) as a “quick bite”, which are short videos on a topic; 2) as a “skill up”, which is a longer collection of videos around a particular topic; and 3) as a “belt”, which is the comprehensive course on a particular subject. A belt will contain a collection of videos which will run 4 – 6 hours.

There are three kinds of belts – green, blue and black. The green belt are for “basic” level courses, blue belts are for “Intermediate” level courses, and black belts are for “Advanced” level courses.

Once participants are enrolled into KLS they are provided with their own unique link to access the site. Logging into the site brings a participant directly to their dashboard which provides video training options and a summary of participant activity. Upon completing a belt, a participant will receive a Certificate of Achievement from KnowledgeWave.
